Ensuring that all the students in Gilmer ISD are successful is our first priority. To assist our students and teachers, we have a committee called the Campus Support Team (CST). This team is made up of teachers and specialists who are experienced in finding innovative ways to help students.

As you may already know, your child's teacher has asked the CST to assist him/her in supporting your child. We have scheduled a meeting for your child at the following date, time, and location:

The Response to Intervention (RtI) process, TIER II, is a level of interventions that involves your child's teachers using differentiated instructional strategies and/or materials with your child and collecting data to see if this approach provides more success for your child. TIER II interventions include various accommodations, tutoring, and ruling out any potential health issues by having our school nurse complete the health screening form to check hearing and vision. Your child's teacher will report to the committee how your child responds to TIER II interventions.

Before we meet, we are collecting some additional data regarding your child. Your child's teacher will be gathering information from your child's records and trying some additional interventions to determine their effectiveness. We believe parent input is critical to this process. I am requesting that you complete the "Parent Report" form that I am enclosing with this letter and return it before the scheduled meeting. It is very important to answer all of the items. If you have any questions regarding the completion of this form, please feel free to contact me.

Please know that the success of your child is our greatest concern. We feel that working together, we can make a difference. Thank you for your support.
